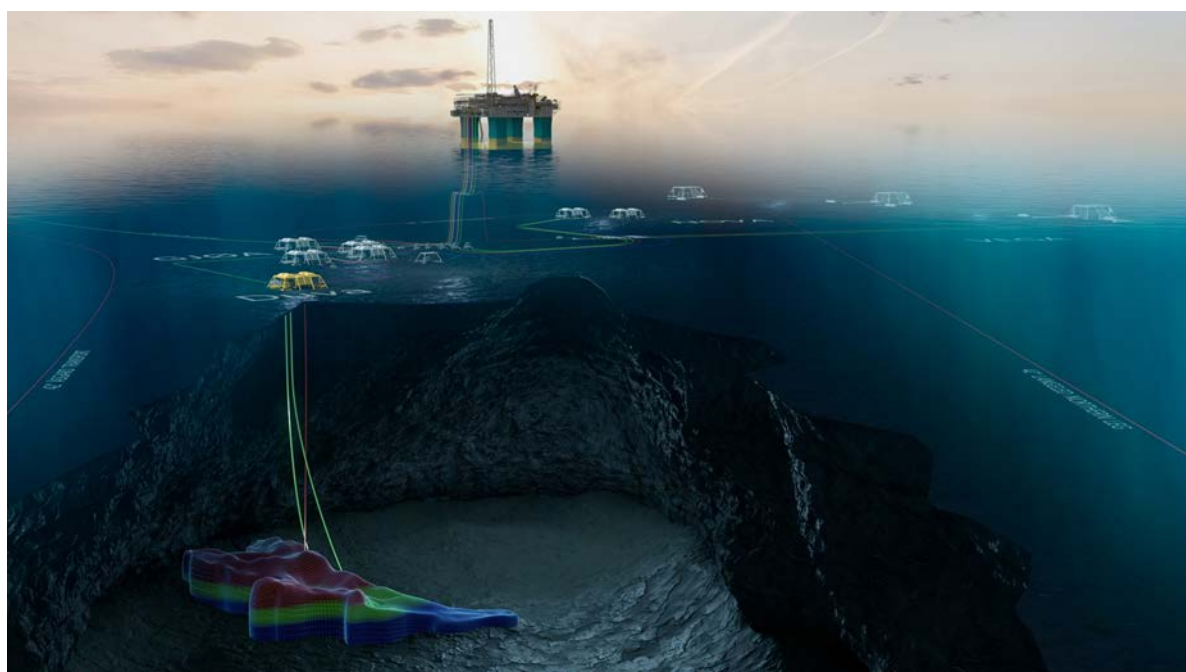

Development of the Duva field in the Norwegian North Sea

Idemitsu Kosan Co.,Ltd. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Shunichi Kito) is pleased to announce that its subsidiary, Idemitsu Snorre Oil Development Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President: Jun Miki)^{*1} has submitted development plan for the Duva field (formerly called Cara), of which the company owns a 30% interest, through Idemitsu Petroleum Norge AS^{*2} (Managing Director: Hiroshi Arikawa) to government of Norway.

The Duva field in PL 636 (formerly called Cara) is located in the Norwegian North Sea, approximately 35 km from the nearest shore and water depth at 360m. The license was awarded in 2012 and the Duva field was discovered by the exploration well in 2016. The production is expected to commence in late 2020/early 2021.

The Duva field will be developed as a subsea tie-back connected to the nearby Gjøa platform for processing and export.

We will continue to work to sustain and strengthen our revenue base by securing reserves through oil and gas field development for our resource development business.
